SoS- Energy Union Strategy

Energy Security Strategy -May 2014: 5 key areas

- Increasing energy efficiency; reaching 2030 energy and climate goals
- Increasing energy production; diversifying supplier countries and routes
- Completing internal energy market; building missing infrastructure links to respond quickly to supply disruptions
- Speaking with one voice in external energy policy
- Strengthening emergency and solidarity mechanisms and protecting critical infrastructure

Romania ' SoS Approach

Energy Strategy Draft (under public consultation) 7pillars

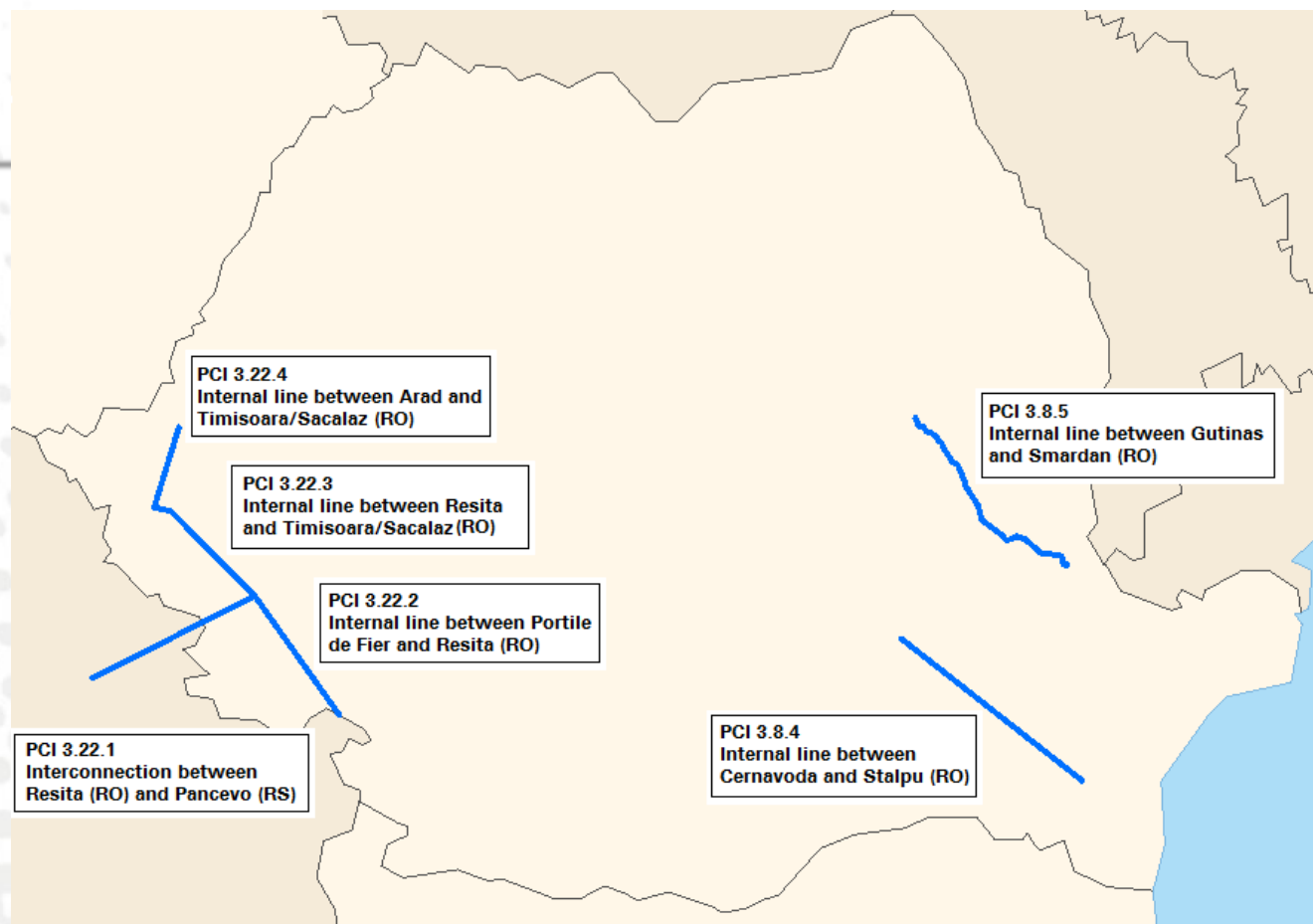
- Increasing Romania's energy contribution to the regional and European markets
- Romania – a regional security provider
- Competitive energy markets – basis for competitive economy
- Clean energy and energy efficiency
- Modernizing the energy governance system
- Ensuring access to electricity and heat for all consumers
- Protection of vulnerable consumer and reducing energy poverty

Major Infrastructure projects (1)

Increasing Energy Transport Interconnection Capacity
Electricity : target 10 % until 2020, 15% until 2030

Common Interest Projects:

- *Project 138*- Black Sea Corridor (2 new 400KV Lines + extension of existing substation)
- *Project 144*-Mid Continental East Corridor(2 new 400KV lines, extension 4 substations, one new substation, passing 2 lines at 400KV)



Major Infrastructure projects (2)

Gas Transportation

Common Interest Projects:

- Bulgaria - Romania - Hungary– Austria Corridor (BRUA 3 main stage);
- South Romania Corridor to pass Black Sea Gases
- SNT Interconnection on International Bus T1
- Interconnection Romania –Bulgaria-, operational from 2017
